

Special Formulas for Running Wisconsin License Plates

The following is a list of formulas, or pointers for running license plate numbers for special Wisconsin plates. Any Questions and/or problems please direct them to your sales representative.

For Sesquicentennial Plates

1. Personalized plates containing an "O"

For these plates, replace letter "O" with a zero "0"

Example: TOMMY would be T0MMY

2. Starting with 5 numbers and ending with the letter "T".

For these use a "0" in front of the five numbers

Example: 12345T, would be 012345T

3. Starting with a letter, ending with a "T" and having four numbers in between

Use a "0" after the first letter.

Example: W1234T, would be W01234T

Miscellaneous Formulas (not limited to sesquicentennial plates)

4. Starting with three letters, then three numbers.

Add a "0" between the letters and numbers *

Example: ABC123 would be ABC0123

5. Five numbers (No letters).

Add two zeros before the numbers

Example: 12345, would be 0012345

6. Starting with two letters, three numbers and ending with a letter.

Add a zero after the first two letters.

Example: AB123C, would be AB0123C

* If no results try the search using a zero **before** the letters or at the end.

Example: ABC123, would be 0ABC123 or ABC1230
